During this time of unprecedented uncertainty from the COVID-19 pandemic, TRT is using its 53 years experience in business to remain focussed on our “One Team” values as a family owned business. We are committed to the safety and well-being of our people, partners and suppliers. Importantly, this also means we continue to be open for business and committed to supporting our customers at this time.

TRT is following New Zealand and Australian Government issued guidelines to minimise the risk to our people and to others, including cleaning and sanitising stations in multiple locations at every site, implementing on and off site protocols, placed a stop to non-essential travel and advising all staff if they are unwell or showing symptoms of COVID-19 they must stay at home.

Our warehouses are well stocked and our teams are providing their expertise and maintaining product delivery schedules. Our branches in Brisbane, Auckland, Hamilton and Christchurch are operational with a full complement of staff to support you and your business.
